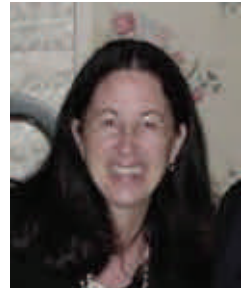
## Commander's Message — Alan Yeater

## MEN'S AUXILLIARY STEAK AND CHEESE

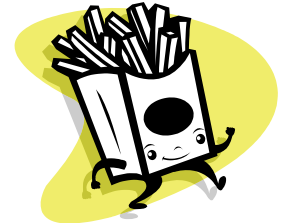
The VFW Men's Auxiliary will be holding Steak and Cheese Night again on Friday, February 8th!!!

Without your patronage – the canteen will cease to exist.

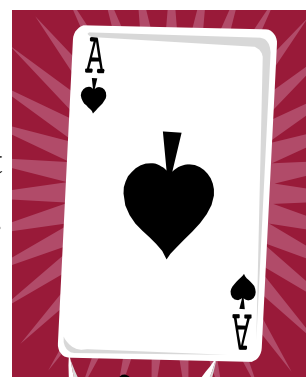
